Our Lady of Fatima Pilgrimage Year, October 23, 2016 - October 14, 2017

Archbishop Aquila has designated Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Church in Lakewood a Pilgrimage site for the Centennial Anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady to the three shepherd children in Fatima. This is a big deal.

He opened the pilgrimage year and consecrated the holy door on October 23rd at the 11:30 Mass. It was a beautiful Mass with wonderful music and an amazing homily by Archbishop Aquila who spoke about the importance of Our Lady of Fatima. Not only did those in attendance receive Jesus in the Eucharist, but also received a Papal Blessing. Pope Francis (through a letter) extended a blessing to all present at the Mass. It was a truly wonderful experience. The

pilgrimage year will go until October 14, 2017. A plenary indulgence will be given to anyone who makes a pilgrimage to the holy door and to obtain it, the following five conditions must be fulfilled:

- Make a sacramental confession.
- 2. Receive Holy Communion.
- Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father and say the Creed and Our Father.
- 4. Have complete detachment from all sin.
- 5. Complete the specific prayers or works as defined by the church as follows: To obtain the indulgence the faithful are called to make a brief pilgrimage to

Holy Door, open in the parish of Our Lady of Fatima, Lakewood, Colorado. It is important that this moment calls to mind the intercession of Our Lady of Fatima, for the entire world, with a reflection on peace especially in the Middle East and the persecution of Christians.

Please take advantage of this amazing spiritual gift! Our Lady of Fatima parish is also blessed to have in their possession, relics of Blessed Jacinta and Francisco. Do not forget to say hello to the beautiful children while you are there!

First Saturday Devotion

Our Lady expressed the need of reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Her Immaculate Heart, and so she asked for the Communion of Reparation to be done on the first Saturdays. She has asked us to receive the Eucharist, go to confession, recite five decades of the Rosary, and spend fifteen minutes meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary for five consecutive Saturdays. She did not mean for this to be done once and never again, she wishes for us to make the Five First Saturdays over and over again.


Won't you do for the Queen of Heaven, our dear Mother what she has asked of you? Please encourage First Saturday devotion at your parish and to your family and friends.


Save the Date

Let's all get excited about 2017, the 100-year anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima. Soon we will send you a daily consecration prayer. In this prayer we will entrust ourselves to Mary to bring us closer and closer to Almighty God.

Just think – when Jesus became present in Mary's womb by the power of the Holy Spirit, Mary became the first tabernacle. Eventually when Mary went to see her cousin Elizabeth, she exclaimed, "My soul magnifies the Lord and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior."
